Admission (2017-18) for Classes from Prep II to Std. IX

Points to note

1. All admissions in the school depend on the existence of vacancies in the respective classes.
2. Online registration is a must. There are no offline admissions.
3. **Online registration is no guarantee to seat being provided for admission.**
4. No new seats will be added and no new sections will be opened in classes from Prep II (earlier name, Mont-II) to Class IX. The existence of vacancies in these classes entirely depends on any existing students(s) leaving the school at the end of academic year for reasons like shifting of residence, job transfer of parent, etc.
5. As on March 01, 2017, the vacancy position is as follows.

6. Additional vacancies are not expected to arise in the above classes or in other classes.
7. Online registration and submission of registrations will be done only for the above classes.
8. *The school will not be able to individually answer telephone calls or reply to mails regarding admission.*
9. For all new admissions, NACH payment through online transaction is compulsory from Term III onwards for payment of school fees, etc.
10. Special point to note:

There are no management quota seats at any level. Do not believe in any misleading information.

Eligibility conditions

1. Candidates should have successfully completed the course in the immediately lower class.
2. For admission in Class IX, if and when vacancy exists, the candidate shall appear in an admission test and shall secure 60% of maximum marks in each of the three papers (viz.) English, Maths and Science. Those who do not clear the admission test will not be considered. Date of admission test would be intimated to the applicants.

Selection Criteria

1. In the above-notified classes,(viz.) III, IV, VI,VII,VIII & IX where vacancies exist, one seat is reserved for CIDCO category applicants in each of the classes.
2. CIDCO category applicants means children of employees of CIDCO, Central Government, State Government and its undertakings, and of Project Affected Persons (PAPs).
3. In the CIDCO category, in any of the above said classes, if more than one registration is received, then selection for the applicable class(es) would be done by priority as follows: First CIDCO, then PAPs, then Central Government, then State Government and undertakings, in that order.
4. Notwithstanding the above, in respect of Class IX, candidates applying in the CIDCO category **will have to clear the admission test** criteria. Those who do not clear the admission test will not be considered.
5. Candidates applying for CIDCO category are also eligible for the general category registration.
6. Consideration for admission in the general category will be based on total points accumulated as per the following parameters.

- 7) Neighbourhood means Kharghar – CBD Belapur. For this purpose, Kharghar limits are from Belpada to **only** Sector 35 Buildings “Arihant” and “Patel Paradise”. All buildings beyond excluded. CBD-Belapur limits start from Artist Colony and extends up to Belpada and excludes CBD Belapur areas on the western side of highway towards Pune.

Admission procedure for selected candidates

- Verification of the documents. **Original birth certificate must be produced for verification.** Or else, selection will be cancelled.
- The child and both parents should report at the school as per time allotted on admission date.
- Payment of fees by Demand Draft for first and second quarter.
- Collection of NACH payment authorization form (from third quarter onwards).
- **Admission is subject to verification and adequacy of documents. There will be no admission if documents are inadequate / incorrect.**
