Greetings to you on the occasion of the second PTM of the academic year 2017-2018. I now request you to take note of the following points and perform your responsibilities as parents.

1. Always send your child in proper, neat and clean school uniform, school shoes, socks and tie.
2. Black sandals are allowed only on the days when it rains heavily.
3. Girl students wearing skirts must also wear white or grey thigh length bloomers every day.
4. Girl students are allowed to wear only white hair bands and hairpins to school.
5. You are once again reminded that no student is allowed to bring mobile phones, cameras, electronic gadgets like I-Pods, etc. to the school or picnic. Such gadgets will be confiscated and not returned.
6. For security reasons, only Gate-1 will be functional for parents and visitors. For the same reason, no entry will be permitted in the school during recess.
7. Note that visitors' time is only from 9.00 a.m. to 11 a.m. Please do not come after 11.00 a.m. and insist on meeting anyone. We will not be able to help.
8. Parents are requested to adhere to the reporting time which is 7:50 a.m. This will help your child to develop punctuality. The school gate will be closed at 8.00 a.m. sharp.
9. The school had in the past provided suggestions on how to reduce the school bag load of your child. Do follow the same. You can also suggest any additional step and we will share the same with parents.
10. Kindly do not bring tiffin box or water bottle to school in case your child has forgotten to bring it with him / her. The child should be trained to bring his / her own tiffin or water bottle to cultivate a sense of responsibility. The school will take care of any need of your child should there be a need.
11. Do pay a visit to the Book Fair in the TT room. Buy for your child a book to promote reading habit. You may also cultivate a culture of gifting a book to someone.
